- 5:45 Walk back to Wentz Concert Hall – Change into concert attire
- 6:00 - 7:00 DGS WE set up, warm up on the stage/get the feel for the hall
- 7:00 - 7:30 North Central WE Warm up on Stage – DGS WE take seats in the hall to listen
- 7:30 Doors open – good time for families to arrive
- 8:00 Concert Begins with DGS WE

Directions to Wentz Concert Hall – All students are responsible for their own transportation for this event

The most direct route is simply to take 55th street west from Dunham all the way into Naperville where it becomes Chicago Ave. Just before you reach downtown Naperville (Washington St) you'll see the hall on your right at the corner of Ellsworth and Chicago. You can park in the garage just past the hall, or on the street behind the hall.
