## **What to Bring to Camp**

- Instrument, music, drill coordinates, (guard needs their flags & equipment)
- dot books & pen – must be the index card type, not paper
- sunscreen & insect repellent
- water – make sure you can wear it over your shoulder – refills provided by band boosters
- brown bag lunch every day
- snacks for breaks
- sunglasses & or hats
- lawn chair or blanket for meals and breaks
- wear comfortable shoes – must be gym shoes, no sandals or flip flops
- section cooler and ice – Section leaders will assign this each day
- pop-up tents for shade

-  1: Start out going EAST on NORFOLK ST toward DUNHAM RD. 0.5 mi
-  2: Turn RIGHT onto MAIN ST/. Continue to follow as it turns into LEMONT RD. 2.4 mi
-  3: Turn LEFT onto PLAINFIELD RD/83RD ST. Continue to follow PLAINFIELD RD/. 0.6 mi
-  4: End at 701 Plainfield Rd Downers Grove, IL 60516-4940
