### *Germany Trip 2008 Update*

Those students in the 2007-2008 Wind Ensemble who have already indicated their interest in traveling next summer to Germany and the Czech Republic are requested to attend a meeting on Monday evening, September 17, 2008 in the DG North High School Auditorium. To date, there are not enough Wind Ensemble students to fill the slots that are allotted to the DGS band program for this trip, so there will be openings for other students to audition. This year, auditions for the IMEA District Band and Jazz Festivals will be held on Monday, October 8, at South Suburban College (Columbus Day). Our school will be assigned a four hour time slot (most likely 4 – 8 pm) for which we will provide bussing to the site. The Jazz Festival will be held on Saturday, November 10, at Joliet West High School, and the Concert Festival will be held on Saturday, November 17, at Oak Park –River Forest High School.
